

## QLS Symposium 2021 Competition

### Conditions of entry

Entrants must have:

- Attended QLS Symposium 2021, hosted by the Promoter on 19 March 2021, held virtually via the EventsAIR platform.

and

- Interact with both virtual sessions and virtual exhibitors to gain 2,000 points (ticket) for one (1) competition entry.

There is no entry fee to enter this draw.

Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these terms and conditions.

By submitting your passport you will be entering this competition and will be considered to be in acceptance of these terms and conditions.

All entries become the property of the Promoter.

### Entry period

Entry into the prize draw opens at 9.30am AEST on Friday 19 March 2021 and closes at 4.30pm AEST on Friday 19 March 2021.

### Entry method

Entrants must interact with both virtual sessions and virtual exhibitors to gain 2,000 points (ticket) for one (1) competition entry into the prize draw. Entrants can earn multiple entry's (tickets).

### Maximum number of entries

An entrant may enter the prize draw multiple times during the entry period.

### Draw details

### **Publication details**

### **Prize claim and date**

The winner must acknowledge receipt of the Promoter's winning notification phone call or email within seven (7) days. The prize will be delivered via courier to the winner's address. The winner will be required to supply a postal or delivery address for the prize.
